Games

*There will be approximately 16 scheduled games, we will not make up rained out games unless you are unable to play a minimum of 10 games. Because we have an uneven amount of teams this year one team will have a bye each week. If the weather is uncooperative and you would like to schedule an extra game please let me know so I can make sure the field is available and the field is ready.

Fields

*Games will be played at two locations. Upper Gower, located across the street from the community center and Gorman 3, located of Cresentville, behind the west side fire dept.

T-Ball Basics

*This league is supposed to be FUN and educational for the kids. Please do not lose sight of this.

*We do not keep score. All games end in a tie.

*The bases shall be at 50 feet.

*All players shall play defense each inning. If you have less than 9 players try to still play the game, but space the players accordingly. The catcher's position should be the first position not played.

*Batting orders should include every child each inning, but only one bat per inning.

*A 12' arc should be drawn from base line to base line in front of home plate. This area is considered a dead zone. If and when batting the ball does not cross this line, play it over as a foul ball.

*Base-runners shall advance one base per hit, with the rare exception of two bases if the hit goes past the outfielder.

*This does not apply to the last batter in the inning. The last batter shall continue to run until he/she gets out or makes it home.

*To reward the defense for a good play, if they get a base-runner out, the base-runner shall return to the bench.

*Every base-runner and batter must wear a helmet. (Wear ball cap under helmet, health reasons)

*No leading off or stealing is permitted.

*Catchers must wear a helmet, facemask, chest protector and shin guards.

*The home team is responsible for the bases, tee and game ball.

*An official game is 5 innings or 75 minutes, which ever comes first.

*Please attempt to play all games on the scheduled day and time. If the weather permits, play the entire game in the grass and stay off the dirt field.

*Please keep everyone off wet ball fields, it is time consuming and expensive to repair fields and get them in good shape again for the next day.

*Please follow the rules of baseball as much as possible. We are getting them ready for the next step up. However, of BOTH coaches agree, do whatever you want. Make it fun for the children.
